

DIRECTIONS TO CONSERVATIVE SYNAGOGUE OF THE HAMPTONS  
258 Redwood Road

*From East Hampton and points east (via Route 114)*

Take Route 114 north to Sag Harbor. Left on Union Street (at light). Left onto Main Street. Right onto Glover Street (across from the Cove Delicatessen). Pass Long Island Avenue on your right, and turn left at the next stop sign onto Redwood Road. Pass the marina on your right, and take the first left onto Cove Road. As the road swings to the right, number 258 will be the second house on the left.

*From Sagaponack or Wainscott (via Sagg-Main)*

Take Sagg-Main Street into Sag Harbor. Left on Union Street. First left onto Main Street. Right onto Glover Street (across from the Cove Delicatessen). Pass Long Island Avenue on your right, and turn left at the next stop sign onto Redwood Road. Pass the marina on your right, and take the first left onto Cove Road. As the road swings to the right, number 258 will be the second house on the left.

*From Bridghampton (via Bridge-Sagg Pike)*

Take the Sag Harbor Tpke into Sag Harbor. Left onto Glover Street (past Canio's Bookstore and across from the Cove Delicatessen). Pass Long Island Avenue on your right, and turn left at the next stop sign onto Redwood Road. Pass the marina on your right, and take the first left onto Cove Road. As the road swings to the right, number 258 will be the second house on the left.

*From Watermill (via Scuttle Hole Road)*

From 27, turn left onto Scuttle Hole Road. Take Scuttle Hole Road until the end, then left onto the Sag Harbor Turnpike. Sag Harbor Turnpike into Sag Harbor, and left onto Glover Street (past Canio's Bookstore and across from the Cove Delicatessen). Pass Long Island Avenue on your right, and turn left at the next stop sign onto Redwood Road. Pass the marina on your right, and take the first left onto Cove Road. As the road swings to the right, number 258 will be the second house on the left.

*From Southampton, West Hampton, and points west*

Take 27 (Montauk Hwy) east. Left at the large green sign pointing toward Sag Harbor (just past East End Clambakes). This will be Sandy Hollow Road. Left at the first light onto North Sea Road. Take North Sea Road to Noyac Road –right onto Noyac Road, following signs to Sag Harbor. Left onto Long Beach Hwy. Right onto South Ferry Road at the traffic circle (sign will say Route 114 South). Cross the bridge into Sag Harbor. Right onto Main Street (opposite the windmill and the wharf). Go straight along Main Street past the stores. At monument (near end of the stores), bear right at fork to stay on Main Street. Right onto Glover Street (across from the Cove Delicatessen). Pass Long Island Avenue on your right, and turn left at the next stop sign onto Redwood Road. Pass the marina on your right, and take the first left onto Cove Road. As the road swings to the right, number 258 will be the second house on the left.

*From Southampton, West Hampton, and points west - Alternate*

Take 27 (Montauk Hwy) east. Left at the large green sign pointing toward Sag Harbor (just past East End Clambakes). This will be Sandy Hollow Road. Left at the first light onto North Sea Road. From North Sea Road, quick right onto North Sea Mecox Road. At end, left on Seven Ponds Road. At end of Seven Ponds there is a stop sign, and fork in the road. Take the middle path onto Lower Seven Ponds Road. Left at end of the road onto Head of the Pond Road. Bear right at fork, staying on Head of the Pond. At end of Head of the Pond Road, left onto Scuttle Hole Road. At end of Scuttle Hole Road, left onto Sag Harbor Turnpike. Sag Harbor Turnpike into Sag Harbor, and left onto Glover Street (past Canio's Bookstore and across from the Cove Delicatessen). Pass Long Island Avenue on your right, and turn left at the next stop sign onto Redwood Road. Pass the marina on your right, and take the first left onto Cove Road. As the road swings to the right, number 258 will be the second house on the left.

**PARKING**

You may park in the driveway, or on the street, but please be particularly careful of the neighbors' driveways.
